After a review of the submitted information, I have a few comments on the above referenced Application.

- 1) As per our discussions, please provide a formal response addressing the co-location issue that we have discussed.
- 2) As per our discussions, adjust the RF exposure exhibit to address the following:
  - a) Classify the device as a portable device
  - b) Correct the MPE exhibit to state that the device or its antenna could operate at less than 2.5 cm distance from a person's body since the keyboard may be used in the lap.
- 3) The users manual statements should be modified to a clearly state "This device and its antenna(s) must not be co-located or operating in conjunction with any other antenna or transmitter" and should also remove reference to the 20 cm distance (page 17 of 96). The co-location statement should also be added to the notes given on page 57 of 96.
- 4) The submittal does not include RF block diagrams. Please provide a block diagram for each of the RF circuits that includes the frequencies as specified by CFR 2.1033(a)(5), OR instead a parts list may be provided as long as it directly lists the entire transmitter board as and OEM module.
- 5) Please confirm that the laptop has been fully configured and tested for DoC requirements as stipulated by ANSI C63.4.
- 6) Is the antenna gain identical for both the base and the keyboard? Please confirm.
- 7) Please provide copy of the processing gain as required by 15.247(f)
