We, Intel Corporation, declare that the device FCC ID: HKX-THE-EGG, has disabled the ad-hoc peer-to-peer functionality. The software and associated drivers will not initiate a network in the following frequency bands.

5150 MHz – 5250 MHz
5250 MHz – 5350 MHz
5470 MHz – 5725 MHz

In the DFS frequency bands, the device operates as a client device and does not support radar detection capability. Additionally the 5600 MHz – 5650 MHz frequency band is notched in this device when marketed in US and Canada.

In the 2400 MHz – 2483.5 MHz frequency range ad-hoc capabilities are disabled on frequencies not supported within the United States.

2467, 2472 & 2484 MHz (Channels 12, 13 & 14) are disabled

The end user is not given the accessibility to change any of the above mentioned settings.
