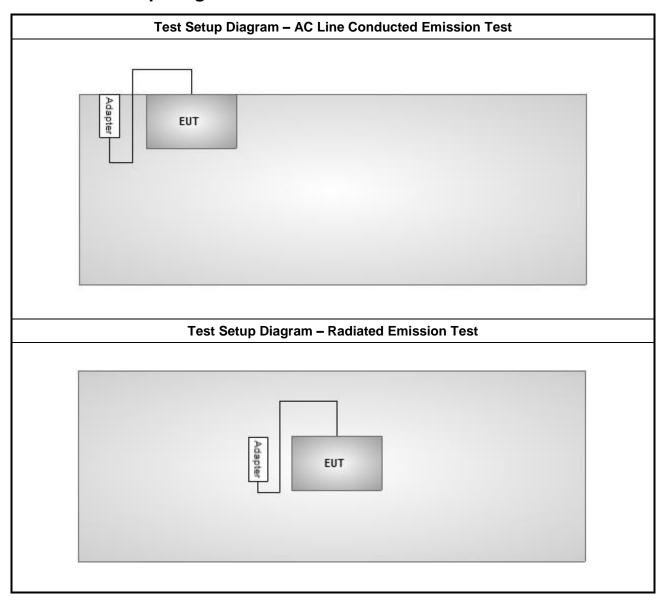

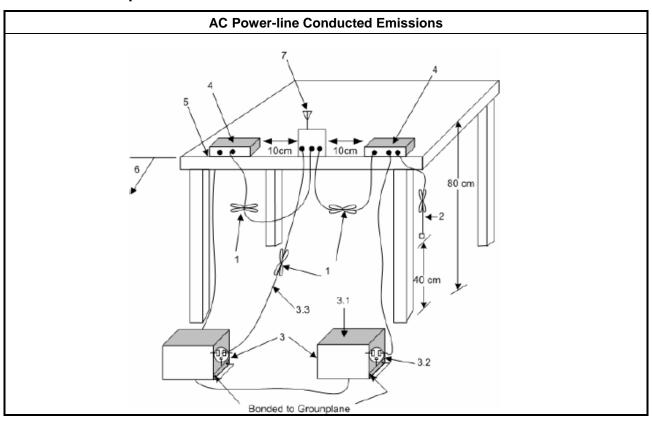

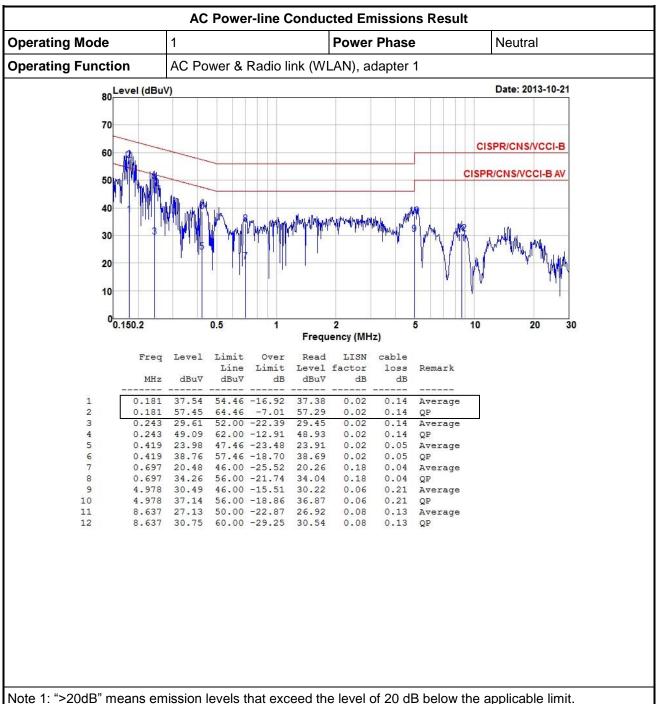

Test Result of AC Power-line Conducted Emissions

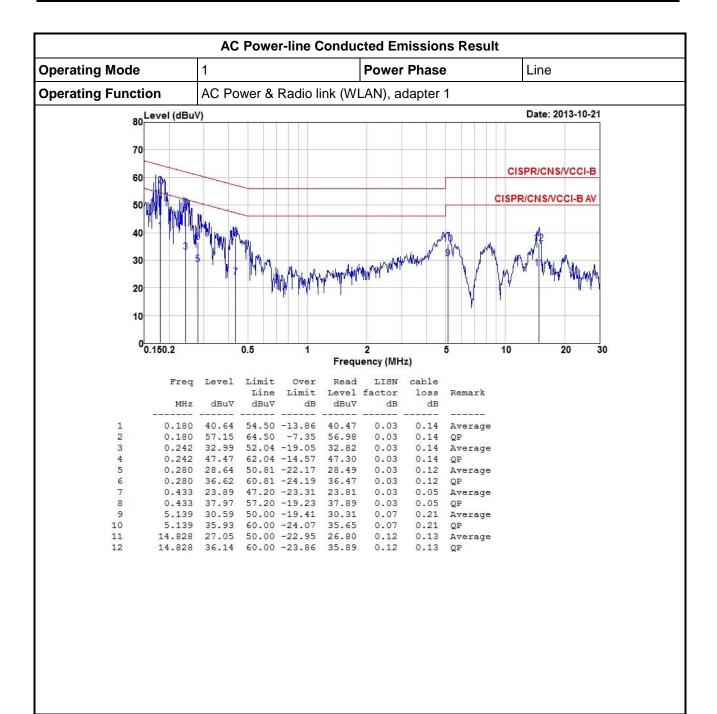

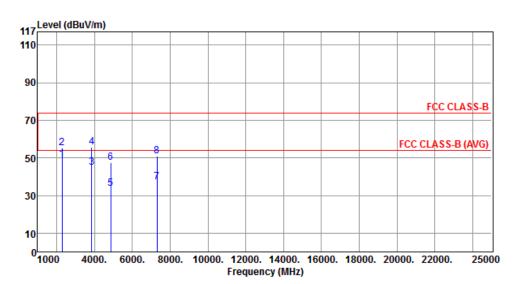


Transmitter Radiated Unwanted Emissions (Above 1GHz)
