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3. TEST METHODOLOGY

The tests documented in this report were performed in accordance with ANSI C63.4. Radiated testing was performed at an antenna to EUT distance 3 meters.

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3.1 EUT CONFIGURATION

The EUT configuration for testing is installed on RF field strength measurement to meet the Commissions requirement and operating in a manner that intends to maximize its emission characteristics in a continuous normal application.

3.2 EUT EXERCISE

The EUT was operated in the engineering mode to fix the Tx frequency that was for the purpose of the measurements.

According to its specifications, the EUT must comply with the requirements of the Section 15.207, 15.209 and 15.247 under the FCC Rules Part 15 Subpart C.

3.3 GENERAL TEST PROCEDURES

Conducted Emissions

The EUT is placed on the turntable, which is 0.8 m above ground plane. According to the requirements in Section 13.1.4.1 of ANSI C63.4.Conducted emissions from the EUT measured in the frequency range between 0.15 MHz and 30MHz using CISPR Quasi-peak and average detector modes.

Radiated Emissions

The EUT is placed on a turn table, which is 0.8 m above ground plane. The turntable shall rotate 360 degrees to determine the position of maximum emission level. EUT is set 3m away from the receiving antenna, which varied from 1m to 4m to find out the highest emission. And also, each emission was to be maximized by changing the polarization of receiving antenna both horizontal and vertical. In order to find out the maximum emissions, exploratory radiated emission measurements were made according to the requirements in Section 13.1.4.1 of ANSI C63.4.

At frequencies equal to or less than 1000 MHz, compliance with the limits in Section 15.209 shall be demonstrated using measurement instrumentation employing a CISPR quasi-peak detector. Above 1000 MHz, compliance with the emission limits in Section 15.209 shall be demonstrated based on the average value of the measured emissions. 3.6 DESCRIPTION OF TEST MODES

The EUT (model: n50, n50 Premium) has been tested under operating condition.

Software used to control the EUT for staying in continuous transmitting and receiving mode is programmed.

After verification, all tests were carried out with the worst case test modes as shown below except radiated spurious emission below 1GHz, which worst case was in normal link mode only.

Condition A (WLAN operation): Channel low $(2412MHz) \cdot mid (2437MHz)$ and high (2462MHz) with 11Mbps data rate were chosen for the final testing.

Condition B (Bluetooth operation): Channel low (2402MHz) • mid (2441MHz) and high (2480MHz) were chosen for final testing.

Condition C (Co-located operation): Radiated among the combination of the Bluetooth mid channel with WLAN low, mid, and high channel.

The field strength of spurious emission was measured in the following position: EUT stand-up position (Z mode), lie-down position (X, Y mode) and the position which the EUT is put onto the cradle. The worst emission was found in lie-down position (X axis) and the worst case was recorded.

4. INSTRUMENT CALIBRATION

The measuring equipment, which was utilized in performing the tests documented herein, has been calibrated in accordance with the manufacturer's recommendations for utilizing calibration equipment, which is traceable to recognized national standards.

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5.2 EQUIPMENT

Radiated emissions are measured with one or more of the following types of linearly polarized antennas: tuned dipole, biconical, log periodic, bi-log, and/or ridged waveguide, horn. Spectrum analyzers with pre-selectors and quasi-peak detectors are used to perform radiated measurements.

Conducted emissions are measured with Line Impedance Stabilization Networks and EMI Test Receivers.

Calibrated wideband preamplifiers, coaxial cables, and coaxial attenuators are also used for making measurements.

All receiving equipment conforms to CISPR Publication 16-1, "Radio Interference Measuring Apparatus and Measurement Methods."





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

6dB Bandwidth (IEEE 802.11b / CH Low)




6dB Bandwidth (IEEE 802.11b / CH Mid)

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



Power Spectral Density






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Band Edges (IEEE 802.11b / CH Low)

Detector mode: Average Polarity: Vertical




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
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Detector mode: Peak Polarity: Horizontal




Polarity: Horizontal Detector mode: Average




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Band Edges (IEEE 802.11b / CH High)

PPSD (IEEE 802.11b / CH Low)




PPSD (IEEE 802.11b / CH Mid)

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




IEEE 802.11b / CH Low

30MHz ~ **26GHz**




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IEEE 802.11b / CH High





For an intentional radiator which is designed to be connected to the public utility (AC) power line, the radio frequency voltage that is conducted back onto the AC power line on any frequency or frequencies within the band 150 kHz to 30 MHz shall not exceed 250 microvolts (The limit decreases linearly with the logarithm of the frequency in the range 0.15 MHz to 0.50 MHz). 


