Subject: Similarities and Differences among CK32

We, Intermec Technologies Corporation, hereby declare that the 42-key and 56-key CK32 handheld computers are identical, having similar hardware, software, features, functionality and application.


These units use the same radio modules and antenna board. They have the same grounding, PCB layout, processors, and operating system. The two units will operate in the same manner and perform the same functions.

The difference between these units is the keypad. One keypad has 42 keys, which includes numeric and function keys. The 56-key option uses an alpha-numeric layout.

We feel that this keypad option will not affect the transmit power or radiation pattern for the CK32 SAR testing, as the radio components are identical and the antenna is above the display.
