# RF Keyboard User Guide

Thanks for Purchasing the "Wireless Keyboard" products, This guide gives you need to get started right away.

#### Hardware Installation

- 1. Battery Installation:
- Open the KEYBOARD battery cap, insert the batteries, and put the cap back.
- 2. Turn off the computer; connect the Receiver connector to the computer then turn on computer.

## Setup RF Keyboard random ID for use

- 1. Aim the front point of the Keyboard towards the Receiver.
- 2. Press the connect button from the Keyboard rear side.
- Press the connect button on the Receiver then release.
  (Please complete step2 to step3 within 15 seconds.)
- Press the Keyboard "Num" Lock key, if you can find the Num indicator light of receiver is changing status, then setup keyboard is completed.

NOTE: If the Keyboard is not moving, please repeat the above steps.

Please re-setup the ID, when replace the battery.

#### Green function:

1. When the keyboard in static state, It will auto turn into sleep mode until the keyboard is moved.

### Software Installation (Driver)

- Insert the CD/Driver.
- . The Driver will auto enter the setup mode.
- Select "KEYBOARD"
- Click the "Multimedia Keyboard" option under "KEYBOARD only"
- Click the "KD/KL/KM/KF/KU/KR Series" option under Multimedia Keyboard
- · Click on the appropriate item for setup.
- · Follow the setups indicated in the screen to complete the keyboard setup.
- Restart your computer system.

#### **Un-Installation:**

If you want to remove the Driver: Please go to window's taskbar → click the Start → Setup → Control desk → Add/Remove program. → Find file KEMailKB and click Add/Remove → Confirm File Deletion, → click YES.

#### Environment

To avoid environmental influence the effective distance between the transmitter and receiver, please noted:

- Do not put the transmitter and receiver on metal cabinet or desk.
- 2. Keep the distance between keyboard, and CRT monitor in 15-20 (cm).
- 3. Keep a distance of more than 1.0 m to avoid interference if there are other RF devices in use.

#### Troubleshooting

If the Products don't work well, please follow the steps as below:

- 1. Check the Keyboard if connected well with computer.
- 2. Check pole of the battery if loaded exactly.
- 3. Reset: Follow the setup of "Software Installation"
