The worst emission levels were found under 1024 x 768 (60 kHz) and therefore test data of this mode is recorded.

4.2 EUT OPERATION CONDITION

- 1. Turn on the power of all equipment.
- 2. PC reads a test program to enable all functions.
- 3. PC reads and writes messages from FDD and HDD.
- 4. PC sends "H" messages to monitor (EUT) and monitor display "H" patterns on screen.
- 5. PC sends "H" messages to modem.
- 6. PC sends "H" messages to printer, and the printer prints them on paper.
- 7. Repeat steps 3-7.


