The Device, FCC ID: <u>I28-EYSNSNZWWZ1</u>, is seeking FCC authorization as a modular transmitter. The EUT meets the requirement for modular approval as detailed in FCC Public Notice DA 00-1407. Compliance to each of the requirements is described below:

- 7. The modular transmitter must comply with any specific rule or operating requirements and the manufacturer must provide adequate instruction along with the module to explain any such requirements.

 Module complies with all relevant requirements.
- 8. The modular transmitter must comply with any applicable RF exposure requirements. Module complies with exposure requirements.
