I have a few comments on this Application. Please note that further comments may arise in response to answers provided to the questions below.

- 1. Please note that in order for a device to have full modular approval as requested in the modular request letter, it must contain all 8 aspects of the modular approval Docket. Please note that the modular approval docket states clearly "The modular transmitter must have its own power supply regulation." Please note that the request letter indicates that this device does not have it own power regulation capabilities but relies on the host for regulated voltage. Please note that 'accept' regulated power is not the same has having its own voltage regulator. As such this device does not meet all 8 criteria for modular approval and would be restricted to a limited modular approval. Please correct the request letter to request limited modular approval and remove the statement that the module meets all 8 criteria.
- 2. FYI Please note that as this device does not meet all 8 criteria (i.e. no internal voltage regulation), it should also be tested for radiated spurious emissions in the host. Has this been addressed?
