I have a few comments on this Application.

- 1.) There appear to be two different test platforms used for this report; one for the EMC report and a second for the SAR report. Please explain the rationale for using a desktop system and a notebook computer.
- 2.) I have some confusion over the test reports. One appears to be an Intentional Radiator to Part 15 Subpart C and the other seems to cover the Unintentional Radiator section of Part 15 Subpart B. When a Declaration of Conformity is used for a "computer peripheral" the FCC logo appears on the label, but it is not necessary to provide a full Certification report. If the DoC approval route is preferred, AmericanTCB does request domestic US point of contact information. Please advise.
- 3.) FYI: In the future, please limit your interior and exterior photos to one view per page. It would also be helpful to rotate the page 90 degrees and use "Landscape" orientation for clarity.
