Re: Request for withholding from public disclosure proprietary information

Dear Sir/Madame,

This request is being made under the provisions of Section 0.457(d) of the Commission's Rules, and Section 552(b)(4) of the Freedom of Information Act. As these sections authorize withholding from public inspection materials, which would be, privileged as a matter of law if retained by person submitting them, and materials which would not customarily be released to the public by that person.
