



Morse code was invented by Samuel F. B. Morse in 1832. Morse code can be transmitted by sound or light, as sometimes happens between ships at sea. Morse code uses a series of stort

and long segments. The short and long segments can be formed by what is called dots and dashes. The Norse code chart is below. Try it yoursalf.



BATTERY REPLACEMENT

REMOVE SCREW TO OPEN BATTERY COMPARTMENT COVER EACH UNIT REQUIRES 1-9V BATTERY (NOT INCLUDE)). ALWAYS REPLACE ALL THREE BATTERIES AT THE SAME TIME REPLACE BATIERY COMPARTMENT COVER AND SCREW. TO OPERATE

- . Switch the ON/OFF VOLUME control ON by sliding upwards. To transmit, press the PUSH TO TALK button with the speaker about 4" from your mouth.
- . To receive a message, release the PUSH TO TALK button.
- . To transmit a code, hold down the PUSH TO TALK button and then tap the CODE KEY button to transmit the desired code characters.
- · After you have finished using your walkie-talkies switch the ON/OFF volume OFF by sliding downwards.
- Press the ON button to use the flashlight. The fashlight turns OFF when you release the buttor.

CAUTION:

- · Operation performance may be affected by surrounding structures and equipment. For best results, use the walkie talkies in an open area.
- . If your walkie talkies are not operating properly install a new battery. The manufacturer recommends alkaline batteries for maximum performance
- · Always turn the walkie talkies "OFF" when you are finished using them.
- . To prevent damage, do not expose walke-talkies to rain or moisture.
- . Do not touch the antenna with your fingers or land, it may cause weak transmission.
- · Your walkie talkies have been set and fully adjusted by the manufacturer prior to shipping. Do not touch internal parts other than replacing the battery.
