Garmin International, Inc. attests that the referenced waiver is applicable to the subject application because of co-location of a Part 95J MURS transceiver with a Part 25 transceiver. Moreover, the three conditions of the waiver are met by the subject equipment as follows:

- (1) Garmin must ensure that the part 25 component of its combination part 95 MURS/part 25 satellite handheld device is a provisioned service that requires each end user to first obtain authorization before accessing the satellite service.

Garmin attests: The satellite service is authorized via the Garmin web page [explore.garmin.com](http://explore.garmin.com). After purchasing a subscription, the satellite service is activated for the unique IMEI number and authorization code provided with the equipment.

- (2) Garmin must include a printed disclosure with its combination part 95 MURS/part 25 satellite handheld device indicating that the part 25 transmission capability of the device is provided by a third-party service provider and must be activated through affirmative action by the consumer.

Garmin attests: In the Owner's Manual, instructions for subscribing to the satellite service and activating the equipment are provided in the section *Activating the Device*. Additionally, in the two sections, *inReach Features* and *SOS*, the user is warned, "you must have an active satellite subscription."

- (3) Notwithstanding today's Order granting Garmin's waiver request, Iridium must continue to comply with the conditions of its license, including any limitations on the number of end-user terminals or subscriber units.

Garmin attests: To the best of our knowledge that Iridium Communications, Inc. will continue to comply with the conditions of its license, including any limitations on the number of end-user terminals or subscriber units.
