In addition to reading its analog and digital sensors, it transmits every 2.5 seconds a 6 byte packet of data to other receiving devices that are currently being developed by Davis Instruments. The transmitter is operating at 916.5 Mhz and uses less than 1 mW of power. Please send the FCC authorization to me, Brett Preston.
