This information has not been disclosed to the public or to a third party. This information pertains to a product that is subject to competition in a highly competitive market and disclosure of this information might enable a competitor to benefit improperly from our hard-won intellectual property. This product will only be sold to Hospital maternity and pediatric wards and will not be sold directly to the general public. The product is professionally installed through a dealer network and is inaccessible to the general public since it is mounted above a drop ceiling or just below the ceiling. This product does not contain any user serviceable parts and is only serviceable by Xmark or our designated technicians.

We attest that the request for confidentiality of internal photos satisfies the following requirement "3) Internal photos can also be held confidential if a non-consumer device is inaccessible to the general public, such as a device mounted on the top of a large tower (or in a fenced enclosure) that is only serviceable by the licensee or his designated technicians."

We would request a period of ten (10) years of protection.
