The purpose of this letter is to request a Class II permissive change to our current FCC approval for an 802.11b/g wireless network card that will be used in various printing products. There have been additional cards added to the line that all contain the same radio. The changes that have been made do not affect the testing that was done to approve this radio. There is also an update to the naming conventions that are used for these wireless cards. The various models are shown below. All models are covered by the Regulatory type/model number LEX-M01-001.
