According to KDB 447498 D04 Interim General RF Exposure Guidance v01

1. 1-mW Test Exemption

Per § 1.1307(b)(3)(i)(A), a single RF source is exempt RF device (from the requirement to show data demonstrating compliance to RF exposure limits, as previously mentioned) if the available maximum time-averaged power is no more than 1 mW, regardless of separation distance.

This exemption applies to all operating configurations and exposure conditions, for the frequency range 100 \(\text{klz} \) to 100 \(\text{klz} \), regardless of fixed, mobile, or portable device exposure conditions. This is a standalone exemption, and it cannot be applied in conjunction with any other test exemption.

D is the measurement distance in meters (m)

 $V/m = 10^{(dBuV)-120)/20}$
