

MODULAR TRANSMITTER REQUIREMENTS

1. The Modular Transmitter has its own power supply regulation located on U7 & U15 (Please See BOM or Schematics)
2. The Modular Transmitter has its own RF Shielding (See External and Internal Photographs)
3. The Modular Transmitter has antenna that complies with section 15.203. It has a UFL at the RF Transmitter Module End to (either hardwired to the antenna or to an MMCX end, depending on OEM configuration)
4. The Module Transmitter was tested in a stand-alone configuration (See Compatible Electronics Test Report)
5. The Modular Transmitter will be labeled with its own FCC ID. Also, the Notebook Computer Manufacturer will be informed to display a label referring to the enclosed module. The exterior label will say: “Contains Transmitter Module FCC ID: J3OM3AWEB56GA” or “Contains TXFCCID: J3OM3AWEB56GA
6. The RF Exposure Limits Mentioned in Section 15.247 (b)(4) of the FCC Rules and regulations are included in the Manual (See Application)
