Limited Modular approval for the device is being requested.


The device does not meet two out of the eight requirements outlined in FCC Public Notice DA 00-1407 Released: June 26, 2000. The reason for the request is that, although it has its own RF shielding, the MINI PCI card depends on the Laptop host to provide additional shielding to be in compliance.

The MINI PCI will be sold to specific Laptop vendors, only. It will not be sold to the general public. This will allow Intel to have full control of the compliance of the MINI PCI card when it is installed on a different Laptop.

Proper installation instructions are provided to the Laptop vendor, so that they are fully aware that additional testing must be performed before selling the Laptop, with the MINI PCI card, to the general public. The Laptop vendor will be provided with specific instructions about the RF exposure, such as not using a different antenna and unauthorized changes to the MINI PCI card is not allowed, and that additional compliance for the radiated emission must be performed.
