Gentlemen:

This is a letter to confirm that Xircom an Intel Company is selling the approved version of the product model number WSAP5000, FCC ID: J3OWSAP5000. This is a single mode wireless LAN Access Point that operates in the 5.15 – 5.35GHz range.

We have recently submitted the application to the FCC for the model WDAP5000, FCC ID: J3OWDAP5000 which is a dual mode wireless LAN Access Point operating both in the 802.11a 5.15 – 5.35GHz range and the 802.11b 2.4GHz range.

We plan on offering upgrade kits but we are still completing our investigation of all implications and rules surrounding these kits to stay within the FCC and other agency regulations.

We are currently working with our marketing personnel to remove this statement of availability of such upgrade kit and Dual mode Access Point until we receive approval from the FCC.

The upgrade kits and dual mode access point were not and are not being sold at this time.
