Reference: FCC ID J3QP-2000; Class 2 Permissive Change Cover Letter

The following is a Class 2 Permissive Change to the referenced FCC ID. The EUT is identical to that which was tested under J3QP-2000, except the fundamental frequency is 1.97Mhz instead of 8.2Mhz. The applicant seeks to modify the existing grant to include the range 1.97-8.2Mhz. This is permitted by 47CFR15.31 (m) when both ends of the range are tested.

This procedure is exactly that which was followed for Knogo FCC ID J3Q3701-Slimline. In that instance, the 8Mhz system was first tested and granted. The 1.97Mhz system test report was submitted as a Class 2 Permissive Change and granted, also covering the 3.25Mhz version.
