After a review of the submitted information, I have a few comments on the above referenced Application.

- Please provide FRN Number of <u>Indyme Electronics Inc.</u> This is now required for all Grantees -(reference MD Docket No. 00-205). To obtain an FRN online, visit the FCC's Web site at <u>www.fcc.gov</u> and click the Commission Registration System (CORES) link. For further assistance, please either refer to the FAQ at this same link; contact the CORES helpdesk at <u>CORES@fcc.gov</u>; or call the CORES helpdesk toll-free number: 1-877-480-3201.
- 2) The units appear to contain a ferrite on the "optional" cables that are shown in the external photographs. The operational description states that not all delivered units contain the wires. However it is not clear if this is something that the installer may be able to install or is only provided when ordered from the factory. There is concern regarding whether the ferrite ships with the unit and whether any necessary directions to inform the installer how to properly install the ferrite are provided (if this is a field upgradable option).
- 3) Please confirm if the optional cables were present in the unit tested. This can not be determined from the test photos provided.
- 4) The labeling provided for the 475, 511, & 514 only contain the Warning statements. The labeling provided for the 440 only shows the FCC ID Number. It is assumed that all units will contain both the FCC ID and warning statements. Please update the labeling to properly include both.
- 5) FYI, RF exposure exhibits are not required to be submitted for devices certified under Part 15.231. Therefore this exhibit will not be reviewed.
