Dear Thu Chan and Claire Hoque,

You are listed as the Technical Contact for the above referenced TCB application. The following items need to be resolved before the review can be continued:

1. The exhibit for Installation guide indicates that a Two-Way Authentication document has been submitted as part of a Class II Permissive Change, which is not correct for this FCC ID. This current C2PC application is the first C2PC application under this FCC ID and the original did not contain two-way authentication documentation. Please either submit this documentation or modify this application's exhibits to remove the two-way authentication references. If this additional exhibit is to be held confidential, which is typical, please update the Confidentiality Request Letter.

2. The Install Guide Section 4 indicates that a separation of 8.01cm from the edge of the WWAN antenna and the User, however the remaining parts of the documentation indicates a separation of 16.2cm.

3. Please confirm that you intended to have the collocation with other mobile transmitters to be restricted to devices operating above 1GHz as implied by the Install Guide.  
[answer] I believe that's always the case, and this is the same wording that all the other installation guides use.

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application. Failure to provide the requested information within 30 days of the original e-mail date may result in application dismissal and forfeiture of the filing fee. Also, please note that partial responses increase processing time and should not be submitted.
