Black Widow Remote Transceiver M/N TXFM5

The David Levy M/N TXFM5 comes with a multi-function LCD Remote Transceiver featuring two-way communication with the vehicle. Each time a remote button is pressed, the LED will flash and the remote will beep to indicate that a transmission is taking place. If the remote is within two-way communication range, the LCD will display the status of the system. The remote is also equipped with a built-in chime that will play a tune as confirmation of some features such as remote starting, clock setting, etc.

- **Button 1** Arms and Disarms the system. This button also activates the system's Panic feature.
- **Button 2** Activates the system's Remote Start feature.
- Button 3 Activates the system's Auxiliary Function, commonly used for trunk release.*
- **Button 4** Activates the system's Auxiliary 2 Function.
- **Button 5** Confirms the system's status. This button also activates the LCD backlight for night time use.
