After a review of the submitted information, I have a few comments on the above referenced Application.

- The circuit board photos (internal photographs) may not normally be held confidential strictly on the basis of trade secrets. Please remove this justification from the letter of confidentiality or provide a better justification. As an alternative, you may use a black marker to "black out" the top of any readable components and provide new internal photographs. Please let us know how you wish to proceed with this issue.
- 2) Please provide schematics for this device. Note that the FCC requires that a schematic be provided, even if just for the main board.
- 3) Please note that the confidentiality Letter does not appear to include the schematics. Please update to include if confidentiality is desired on these.
- 4) Given information provided it would be suggested to add operational description to the confidentiality letter.
- 5) It is uncertain where the generation circuitry is, but it does not appear to be on the main board. For instance, is additional circuitry between the antenna and the shield? If so, please provide additional internal photographs as necessary of this circuitry. Even if the module is made by another manufacturer, photographs must be included with the application.
