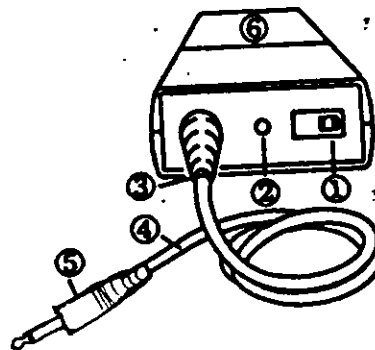
***User Manual***

### INSTRUMENT BELT PACK TRANSMITTER OPERATION

1. Open the battery door by sliding towards the arrow.
2. Insert a 9V battery into the battery holder according to polarity(+)and(-) indication marked on the battery housing.
3. Slide the battery door back on until it locks.
4. Push the power switch to the "ON" position. The LED will illuminate RED. If the LED indicator does not go on at all, it indicates that the battery is either dead or not properly inserted. Check the battery positioning and try again. If the LED does not go on, change the battery.
5. If your wireless system is not going to be used for an extended length of time, removing the battery will prevent leakage and damage.

1. Power on/off switch
2. Power on LED indicator
3. Heavy duty strain relief
4. 1/4" coax cable
5. Input plug for guitar or bass input
6. 9V battery compartment
