

# **RF Exposure Requirements**

Product Description: Bodypack Transmitter

Model No.: UT-61, UT-51

FCC ID: JEBUT-61

According to the KDB 447498 D01 v06 section 4.3.1, for 100 MHz to 6 GHz and test separation distances  $\leq 50$  mm, the 1-g and 10-g SAR test exclusion thresholds are determined by the following:

$[(\text{max. power of channel, including tune-up tolerance, mW})/(\text{min. test separation distance, mm})] \cdot [\sqrt{f(\text{GHz})}] \leq 3.0$  for 1-g SAR and  $\leq 7.5$  for 10-g extremity SAR, where

- f(GHz) is the RF channel transmit frequency in GHz
- Power and distance are rounded to the nearest mW and mm before calculation
- The result is rounded to one decimal place for comparison

## **Calculation Result:**

Tx frequency range: 520-608 MHz, 614-617 MHz, 652-663 MHz

Min. test separation distance: 1.5 mm

Maximum Conducted Output Power: 7.77 dBm

RF channel transmit frequency: 520.125 MHz

Result: 2.88

Limit: 3.0

The exclusion thresholds is  $2.88 < 3$ , so the transmitter complies with the RF exposure requirements and the SAR is not required.
