WE ARE SUBMITTING A CLASS II PERMISSIVE CHANGE AS SUGGESTED BY YOUR MR. RICH FABINA ON OCTOBER 29, 2002, COPY ATTACHED.

THE SUBJECT MICROWAVE OVEN IS PRESENTLY GRANTED WITH A ROTATING GLASS TRAY. WE HAVE DEVELOPED ANOTHER VERSION THAT CHANGES THE ROTATING GLASS TRAY TO A ROTATING STIRRER FAN. NO OTHER CHANGES HAVE BEEN MADE; MECHANICAL OR ELECTRICAL. THUS, WE WANT TO APPLY THE SAME FCC ID: FOR BOTH VERSIONS.

IN ADDITION, AT THIS TIME, WE ARE APPLYING AN ALTERNATE TOSHIBA MAGNETRON FOR THIS FCC ID:

TEST REPORTS AND PHOTOS COVERING THE ABOVE, ALONG WITH THE OTHER FCC REQUIRED MATERIALS WILL SOON BE ATTACHED TO THE 731 APPLICATION.

THERE ARE FOUR (4) TEST REPORTS; GLASS TRAY & STIRRER FAN; PRESENT FCC TEST METHOD, & FUTURE CISPR-11(1990). WE CONFIRM THAT THESE TEST REPORTS ARE APPLICABLE TO ANY OF OUR MICROWAVE OVENS BEARING THE SUBJECT FCC ID:

LASTLY, WE ASK YOU TO IGNORE THE WORD "COMMERCIAL" INADVERTENTLY SHOWN ON THE 731 FORM, ITEM 11, "DESCRIPTION OF PRODUCT". PLEASE SIMPLY ISSUE THE GRANT WITH THE DESCRIPTION SHOWN AS "MICROWAVE OVEN". THANK YOU.

Tom,

I'd recommend a Class II permissive change for the changes mentioned in item three.

By the way, the application doe not have to be filed with the Commission. A Telecommunications Certification Body (TCB) can process your application.

The advantage to using a TCB is your grant will be issued in a matter of days not weeks. In other words, the TCB will process the Certification in days while the Commission will take weeks to process the same application.

FIRSTLY, PLEASE EXCUSE MY "CAPS LOCK". THANK YOU.

1) WE ARE NOT SURE HOW TO COMPLY WITH THE NEW MICROWAVE OVEN REGULATIONS FOR CISPR 11, ON ALREADY GRANTED UNITS. MUST WE SUBMIT A PERMISSIVE CHANGE WITH THE NEW TEST REPORT ? DO WE NEED ALL THE SAME PAPERWORK AS FOR AN ALTERNATE MAGNETRON, FOR EXAMPLE ? OR JUST THE NEW TEST REPORT ?
(THESE NEW RULES ARE EFFECTIVE JULY 12, 2005 FOR EXISTING PRODUCTS.)

2) IN RESPECT TO THE ABOVE, PLEASE ADVISE IF THE EFFECTIVE DATE IS THE DATE OF MANUFACTURE, OR THE DATE OF IMPORTATION FOR FOREIGN MADE UNITS.

3) WE HAVE A PRESENTLY GRANTED MICROWAVE OVEN UNDER FCC ID: JHU105ZZ. THIS UNIT EMPLOYS A ROTATING GLASS TRAY. WE PLAN TO PRODUCE ANOTHER VERSION OF THIS SAME UNIT THAT EXCHANGES THE GLASS TRAY FOR A STIRRER FAN. THE FAN WILL BE COVERED BY A CERAMIC SHELF TO CREATE THE FLOOR OF THE OVEN.

THE FCC TEST REPORT RESULTS FOR BOTH VERSIONS, USING THE SAME ELECTRICAL COMPONENTS AND MAGNETRON ARE SIMILAR, AND MEET FCC REQUIREMENTS.

SIX (6) SMALL SIZE JPGS ARE ATTACHED FOR YOUR REFERENCE; E1100-A, -B, -C ARE THE PRESENTLY GRANTED OVEN. S1100-A, -B, -C ARE OUR NEW VERSION.

OUR QUESTION: CAN WE USE THE SAME FCC ID; JHU105ZZ FOR BOTH VERSIONS ? DO WE HAVE TO FILE A PERMISSIVE CHANGE OR A COMPLETE NEW APPLICATION ? OR SIMPLY DO NOTHING IF ELECTRICAL COMPONENTS/MAGNETRON ARE UNCHANGED ?
