After a review of the submitted information, I have a few comments on the above referenced Application.

- 1) The TX board appears to contain an SMA connector. If so, this device does not appear to be in compliance with 15.203. The test report cites permanently connected, but photographs, schematics show otherwise. Please explain/review/correct as necessary.
- 2) This device appears to incorporate a standard antenna connection. To meet the requirements of 15.203 using a standard connector, this device must be limited to Professional Installation only. This requires a cover letter requesting and justifying how the applicant ensures professional installation to be provided. The letter should address the following 3 items:

a) Marketing

example:

The device cannot be sold retail, to the general public or by mail order. It must be sold to dealers or have strict marketing control.

b) Requires professional installation;

examples:

- installation must be controlled.
- installed by licensed professionals (EUT sold to dealer who hire installers)
- installation requires special training (special programming, access to keypad, field strength measurements made) What is unique, sophisticated, complex, or specialized about your equipment which REQUIRES it to be installed by a professional installer?

c) Application

example:

- The intended use is generally not for the general public. It is generally for industry/commercial use.
