Compliance to FCC Part 15.105

15.105 does not apply to the ProxProgrammer or any HID Proximity Reader because these devices are intentional radiators and not Class A or Class B un-intentional radiators.

The receivers is HID products are not receivers according to the FCC definition. They do not have a local oscillator nor do they emit any spurious emissions. The receivers consist of an analog bandpass amplifier followed by a detector.

The label statement requirement for these HID products is in accordance with 15.19 (3). This statement usually appears on the product label along with the FCC ID number.
