I have a few comments on this Application. Depending on your responses, kindly understand there may be additional comments.

- Kindly recheck your radiated EIRP for Part 24. You are showing a radiated EIRP of just 110 mW while you are loading the antenna with a conducted power of over 800mW. Is this correct? The value just seems too low.
- 2.) From the manual, this appears to be a three band phone with DCS and GSM 900 wich cannot be authorized in USA. Please address.
- 3.) The Manual does not have any compliance information. Please correct.
- 4.) Can this Smart Phone connect directly to a computer? If so, then either DofC or Certification as a computer peripheral may apply. Please explain.
- 5.) Please review Section 4.1.4 of your Test Report. Kindly provide calculations to explain your listed columns when the device is in either Mode 1 or Mode 2. In addition, a listing of the antenna and antenna factors used and signal generator levels would be appropriate too. My object is not to place an unnecessary burden on the laboratory, but since the radiated EIRP is so low, my concern is trying to understand your radiated EIRP methodology.
- 6.) For the SAR report, a measurement indicating the distance from the phantom to the phone when the EUT is in the holster is required. Kindly provide this information.
