To Whom It May Concern:

Pursuant to the requirements of Section 25.129(d) of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 25.129(d), ICO Global Communications ("ICO") submits this letter to confirm that the above-referenced device is designed for use with ICO's mobile satellite service ("MSS") network, which the Commission has authorized ICO to operate using 2 GHz MSS frequencies. Specifically, ICO was granted a reservation of 2 GHz MSS spectrum in its Letter of Intent ("LOI") authorization on July 23, 2001,¹ and the Commission confirmed the system's operational status on May 30, 2008.² On January 15, 2009, the Commission granted license authority for mobile earth terminals that will communicate with the ICO-G satellite, and with the ancillary terrestrial component of ICO's MSS system.³
