- 2.) Was an equipment list supplied with the test reports? I didn't find it. If so, please identify where it is.
- 3.) Was equipment tested in three orthogonal planes as required in ANSI C63.4?
- 4.) K68ND241A had a label photograph which was too blurry for submission. Please correct.
- 5.) FYI: Not all Exhibits uploaded to AmericanTCB should be labeled Confidential. Only those items, which were identified in your Request for Confidentiality letter, should have been checked. This has caused extra processing time on these Applications.
