Introduction

Thank you for purchasing the Belkin *Bluetooth* Comfort Mouse. With a simple 3-minute setup, this wireless *Bluetooth* Mouse will talk directly to your laptop enabled with *Bluetooth* technology without a dongle.

System Requirements

Operating Systems:

- Mac OS[®] X v10.47 or later
- Microsoft[®] Windows[®] XP, 2000, and Vista[®]

Hardware:

• Laptop enabled with *Bluetooth* technology

Note: If you have a Windows XP, 2000, or Vista operating system, please run the included installation CD to enable the horizontal scroll function on the Mouse.

Turning the Mouse On:

- 1. Place the two AA batteries into the compartment located on the bottom of the Mouse.
- 2. Turn the Mouse on by pressing the gray on/off button located on the bottom of the Mouse.



If you plan to pair the mouse with your laptop enabled with *Bluetooth* technology, please also try instructions provided by the laptop manufacturer. If you plan to pair this mouse with a separate *Bluetooth* adapter, please also try the instructions provided by the manufacturer of the adapter.

For Windows Users:
