

Operation description:

- Receiver Power input: 120Vac/60Hz.
- 1. First plug receiver plug to get electricity.
- 2. Receiver there are three mode can be select:
 - I. Remote: that mean receiver are ready to get handset command control solenoid on/off.
 - II. OFF: receiver's solenoid always off.
 - III. ON: receiver's solenoid always on.
- 3. Receiver learn ID code way: press receiver's learn button then receiver will beep, the after user press handset any button if receiver learn ok receiver will sound beep, beep......
- 4. User press handset button control solenoid on/off.
 - I. ON button: solenoid on.
 - II. OFF button: solenoid off.
