I have a few comments on the above referenced Application.

Basic Information

1) The device contains an antenna connector (see external photographs, users manual photographs, and description of removable antenna given in the users manual). This does not meet the requirements of 15.407(d). Your email suggested that the device will not operate in the 5.15-5.25 GHz band. However the product is capable of transmission in this band since it is shown in the test report (pages 10, 11, and several pages of test data throughout the report, RF exposure, 731 Form, etc.). Note that information shows that the device is capable of TX in both normal and Turbo modes in the 5.15-5.25 GHz band. If the manufacturer chooses to proceed forth by eliminating the channels in 5150-5250 MHz band for use in the United States, then we will require an attestation from the manufacturer (on D-Link letterhead) that states:

"This device will not allow the end user to select channels in the 5150-5250 MHz band. Software and/or drivers will not be provided to allow operation in these bands."

Additionally, all exhibits referencing the 5.15 - 5.25 GHz band will need to be modified.
