You had asked for some clarification on certain issues to do with the operation of the device, specifically:

Please explain if the collection mode process is considered a manual or automatic in nature (I could not derive enough information from the manual to determine this)? Also, please explain how the device complies with 15.231 (a)(3). The Theory of operations does not seem to adequately address this.

The collection mode can be either manual (via operator) or automatic (via triggering by motion sensors connected into the system). In both cases the collections are random events, triggered by the movement of vehicles/persons via motion sensors or by the user of the system initiating a collection manually. There are no collections at pre-determined intervals so the system meets 15231(a)(3) requirements.
