According to KDB 447498 section 4.3.1, the 1-g SAR test exclusion thresholds at test separation distance  $\leq$  50 mm are determined by:

[(max. power of channel, including tune-up tolerance, mW) / (min. test separation distance, mm)] \*  $\left[\sqrt{f(GHz)}\right] \le 3.0$ 

The tune-up power is  $\leq$ -29 dBm, therefore the highest tune-up power is -29.00 dBm (0.0013 mW) @ 433.660 MHz (worst -32.00 dBm (0.0006 mW) @ 433.920 MHz

When the minimum *test separation distance* is < 5 mm, a distance of 5 mm according to 5) in section 4.1 is applied to determine SAR test exclusion.

So,

( 0.0013mW / 5mm ) \* ( 0.43366GHz ^0.5 )= 0.00017

[(max. power of channel, including tune-up tolerance, mW) / (min. test separation distance, mm)] \* [ $\sqrt{f}(GHz)$ ] = 0.00017 < 3.0

Therefore, standalone SAR measurements are not required for both head and body.

Note:

1. The tune up power referred the operation description and TMWK2109000552KR (under issue date November 30, 2021) for SAR test exclusion purpose.
