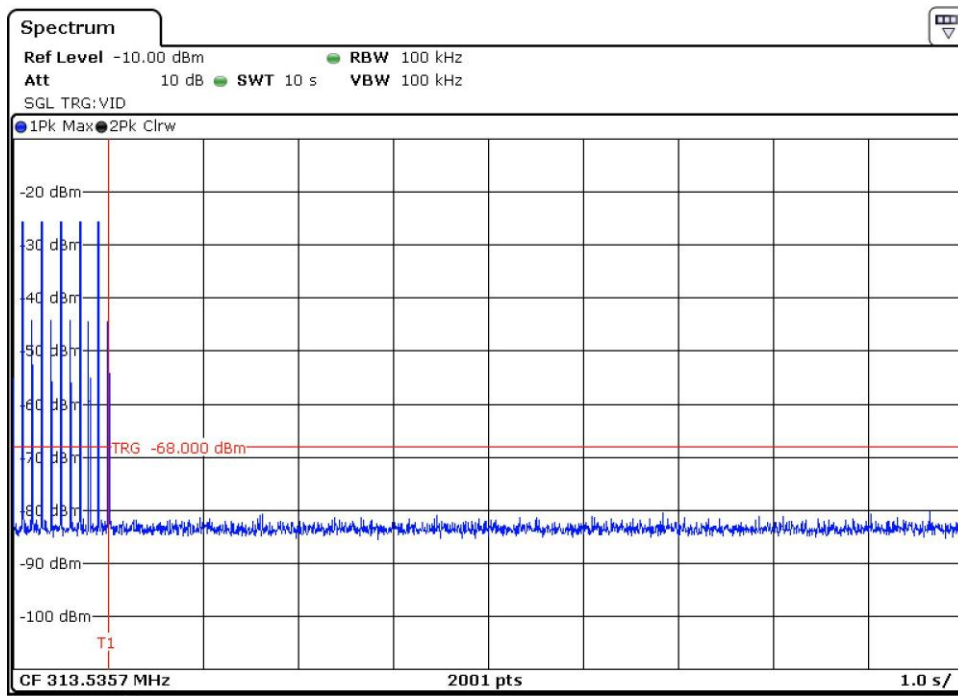

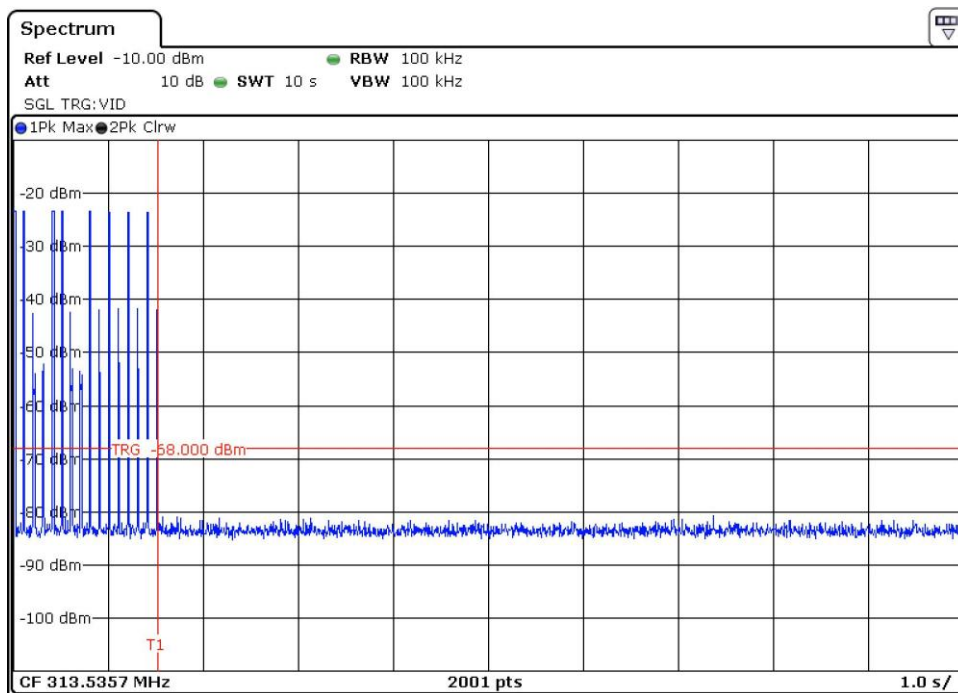
Periodic Operation Characteristics

15.231 (a) (1) A manually operated transmitter shall employ a switch that will automatically deactivate the transmitter within not more than 5 seconds of being released.

Close button



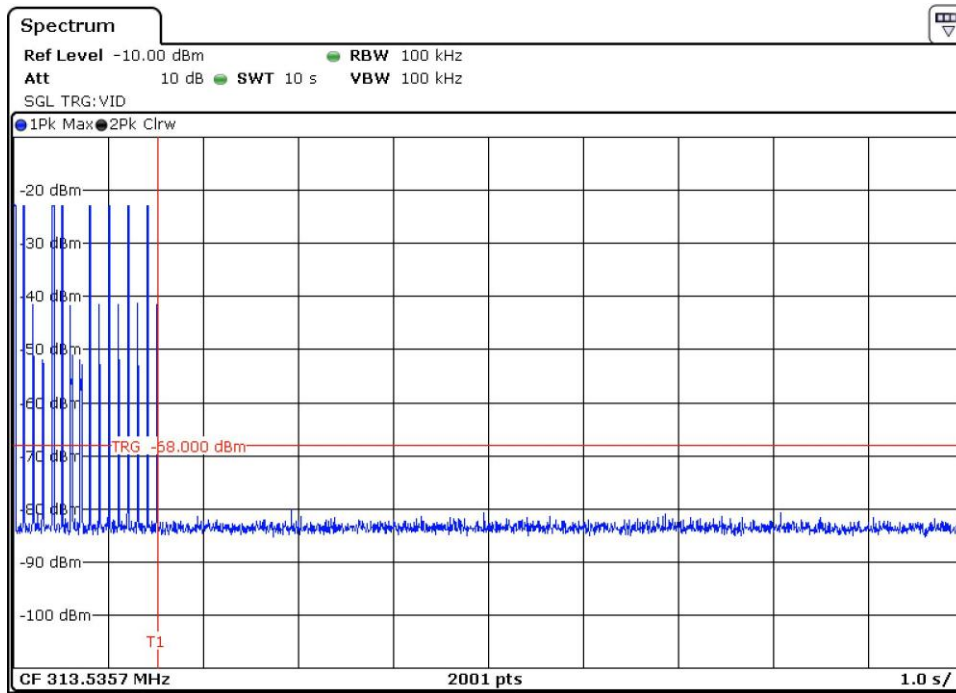
Door left button



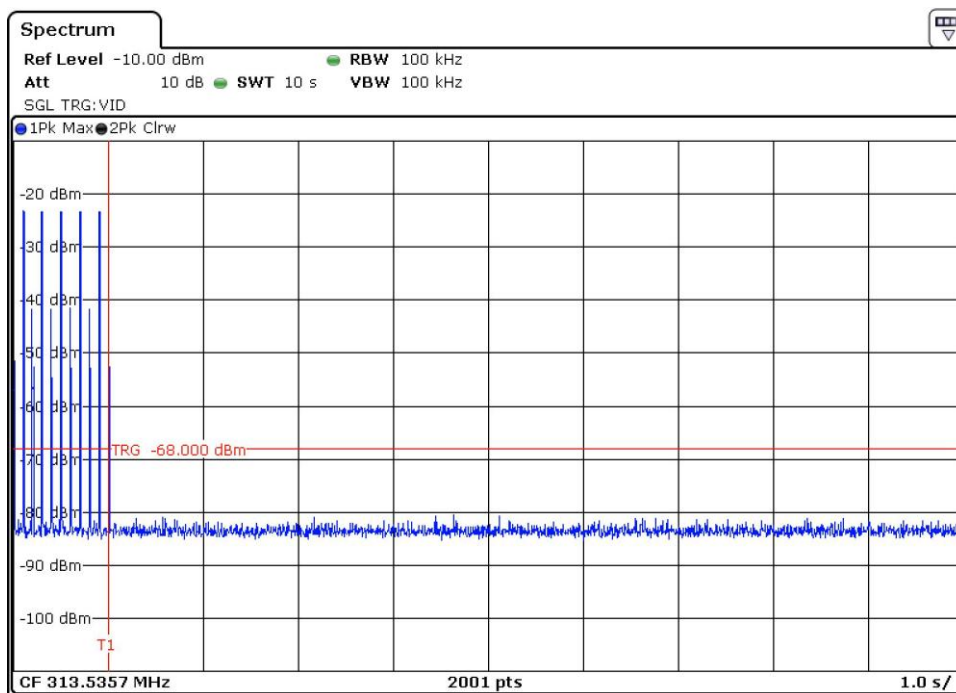
T1 = release point

Door right button



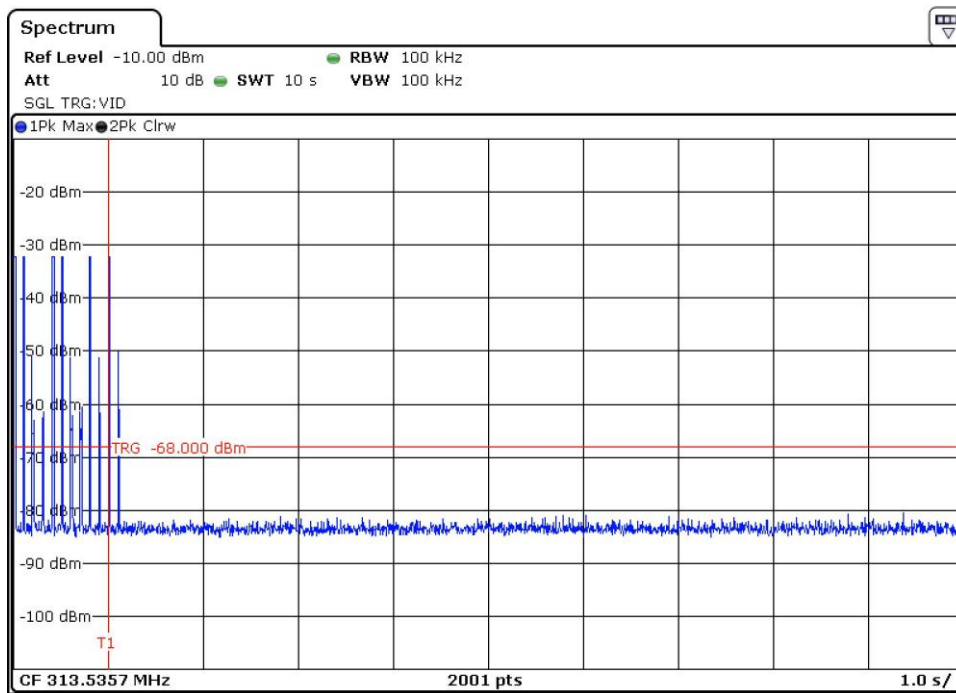
Open button



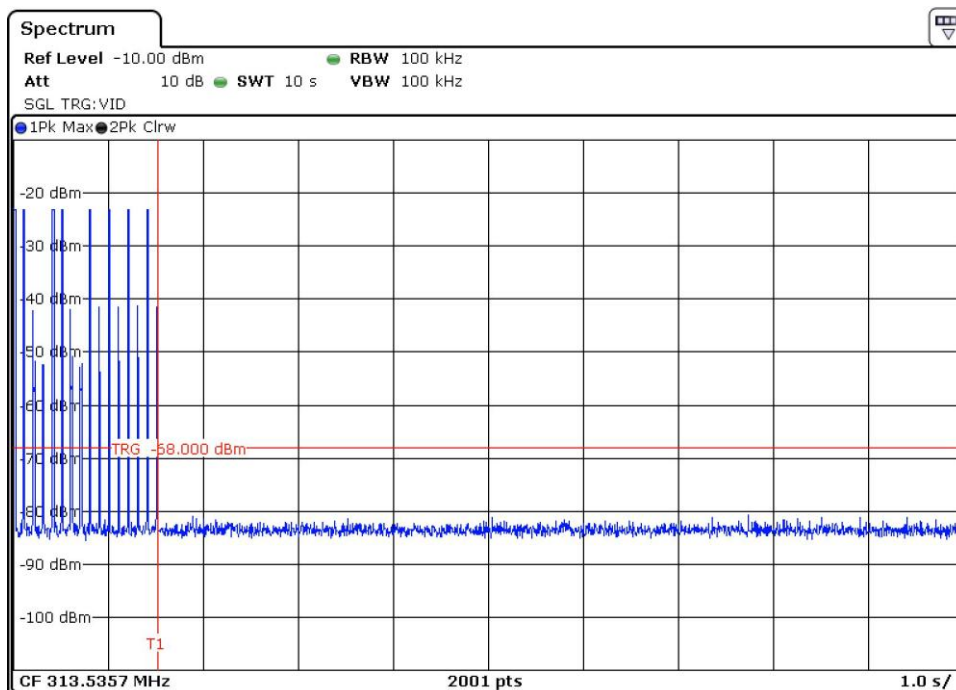
T1 = release point

Panic button

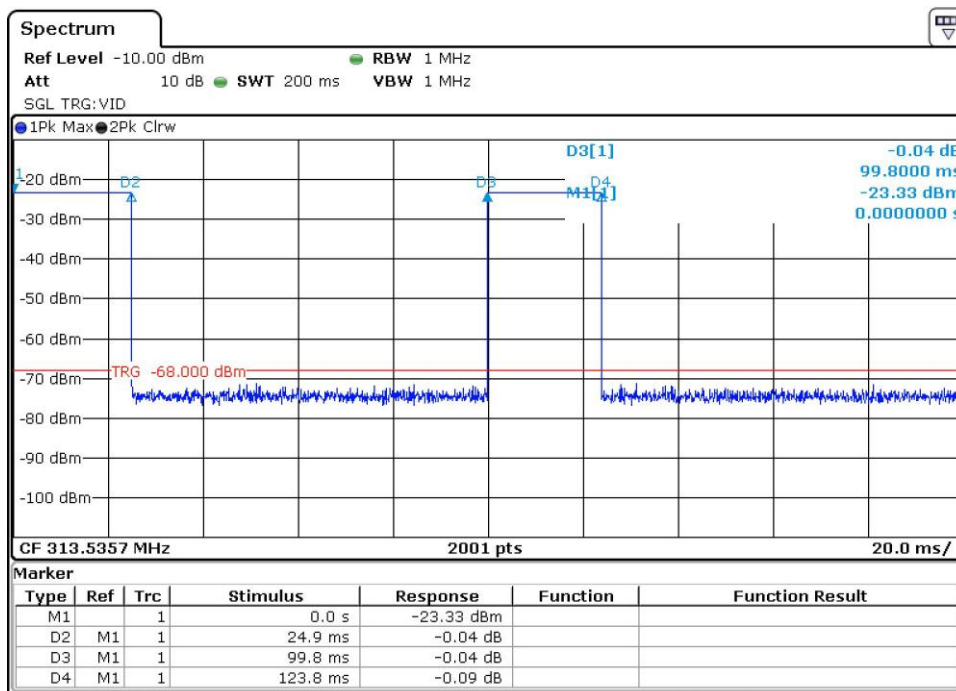
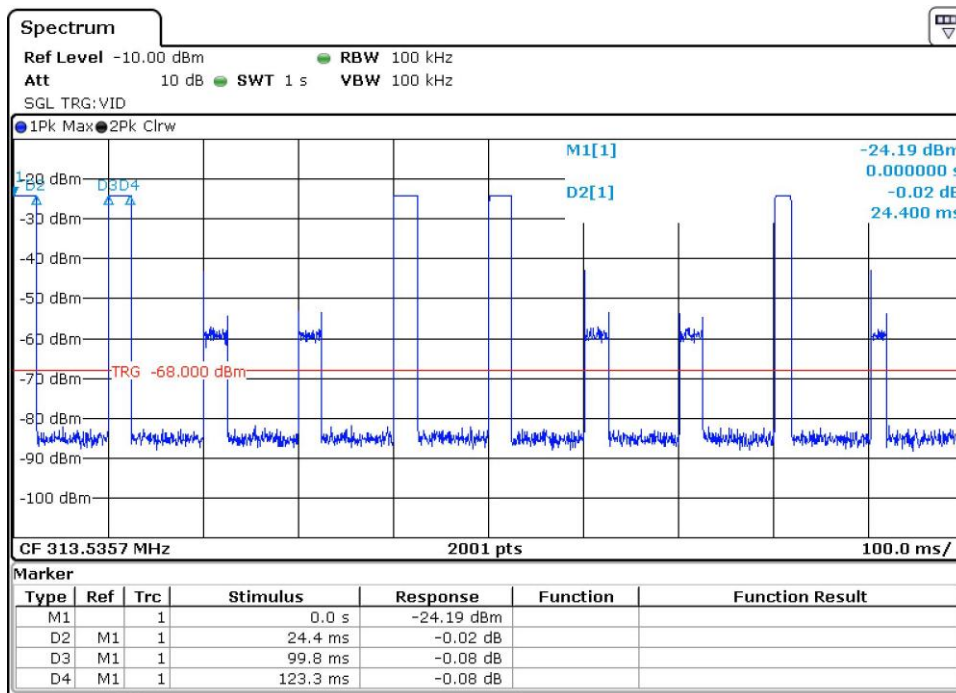


Trunk button

Worst case duration for a single pulse transmission in any 100ms time window



The measured worst case duration for a single pulse transmission in any 100ms time window is 25.1 ms.

Maximum transmitting duration in every 100 ms period: 24.9 ms

Averaging factor = $20 \cdot \log(24.9/100) = -12.1$ dB
