









Main difference between the five Audéo devices:

- Different power supply: Zink air battery for Audéo M 312, 312T and 13T.
Lithium Ion Z23/85L1 for Audéo M R and RT + Li Ion power management PH1.0
- T-Coil and None T-Coil
- RGB LED & No LED
- Programming interface: 4pins or CS44 connector

The five Phonak Audeo M devices listed in the table above all have identical matching circuit and loop antenna. Therefore, the radio frequency path is identical for all five Audéo products.


