



Do not use this TV near moist surroundings. For example, do not use it near a bathtub, washbowl, kitchen sink or laundry tub, in a wet basement, or near a swimming pool, etc. The TV set should not be exposed to dripping or splashing conditions. Keep all liquid from getting into the TV set for safety.

6. CLEAN ONLY WITH DRY CLOTH

Unplug the TV from the wall outlet before cleaning. Do not use liquid cleaners or aerosol cleaners. Use a damp cloth for cleaning.
