Clock

APPENDIX-TROUBLESHOOTING

IDENTIFYING PROBLEMS

If there are any problems when using the product, please first consult the list below. If the list below does not contain a solution to your problem, please call our Customer Service Center immediately.

SETUP AND CONNECTION ISSUES

THE TV DOES NOT TURN ON.
Please check your power cable connection and make sure you have turned on the Power Switch located on the back of the TV
by the power adaptor.
BASIC CHANNELS CANNOT BE DISPLAYED.
Check the connection between the TV and the antenna/cable/set-top box. Make sure channels have been recognized. Refer to
the Auto Ch Search under the Setup Menu Options section in this manual.
HOW TO SETUP CABLE CHANNELS
Register cable service with your local cable service provider and connect the cable box they provide you with to the cable
connection on the TV.
HOW TO SETUP SATELLITE CHANNELS
Setup your Satellite dish and then connect your satellite receiver to the TV.
FAILURE TO SEE DIGITAL BROADCAST CHANNELS
Check your antenna cable connection. Check if the digital cable connection is correctly connected to your antenna cable.

OSD MENU & REMOTE CONTROL ISSUES

THE REMOTE CONTROL IS NOT FUNCTIONING CORRECTLY.

- Change the batteries with the new ones.
- Check the polarity of the batteries.
- Point the angle of the remote control towards the product or check if there are any obstacles between the remote control and the TV set that may be blocking the infrared signal.

TV CHANNELS CANNOT BE CHANGED WITH THE TV REMOTE CONTROL.

- Press [SOURCE] and select <TV> using the TV's remote control.

THERE IS NO SIGNAL ON THE SELECTED SIGNAL SOURCE.

- Check the signal connection between the TV and the desired device.

A MENU/OPTION CANNOT BE SELECTED

Not all menus and options are available under all signal sources. Some specific menu/options can only work under certain signal source. If you find the menu/option you want to select is grayed out, the menu/option is not available under the currently selected signal source. Please change the signal source and try again.

PICTURE QUALITY ISSUES

POOR IMAGE QUALITY OR NO PICTURE

Make sure the power cable and all signal cables are securely connected.

RIPPLED OR FLICKERING IMAGE DISPLAYED UNDER TV MODE

The TV signal received may be too weak or might be interfered. Please try to re-scan all TV channels first. If the problem continues, look for any forms of possible interference located near the TV, such as: a wireless phone, Wi-Fi router, microwave oven, hair dryer, etc., and either remove them or turn them off when you are watching TV.

NOISE DISPLAYED ON THE SCREEN IN TV MODE

Check if the channel has been selected correctly.

Try to adjust the position of the antenna for best result.

Check if your antenna is damaged or any connections are broken. If so, please replace your antenna or signal cables. ONLY CERTAIN TV CHANNELS ARE IN BLACK AND WHITE

- 1. Check if the program is being broadcast in black and white.
- 2. Try to adjust the Hue or Contrast in OSD menu.

SOUND ISSUES

POOR SOUND QUALITY

- 1. Check if the program is in stereo. Stereo may not work well in areas with bad reception. Try using Mono for these areas.
- 2. Check your audio cable.
- 3. Check if other channels also have similar problems.
- THE IMAGE CAN BE SEEN BUT THERE IS NO SOUND
- 1. Press the volume buttons to increase the sound.
- 2. Check all audio connections.
- 3. Try viewing from a different source (ex. DVD player) If the video has sound, check with your cable company. If there is no problem with the cable receiver, then call our customer service.
- 4. Check if the internal speakers are <OFF>.

THERE IS DISTORTION AFTER THE VOLUME IS INCREASED

Try to adjust the external devices connected to the TV (Digital channel receiver, DTV, DVD, Cable channel receiver, video) If you can adjust your sound, try to balance the volume of the TV and the external device.

CHANNEL ISSUES

CHANNELS DO NOT APPEAR CORRECTLY

- 1. Reinstall the antenna connectors.
- 2. Set to Memorize Channels in the Automatic Channel setting.
- 3. Consult your local cable/broadcast/satellite TV content provider for solution.

SOME OF MY CHANNELS ARE NOT BEING DISPLAYED

- 1. Change the location or direction of the antenna.
- 2. Try to select the channels by keying in the channel number and use the add/delete button to have the TV memorize those channels.

VGA MODE ISSUES

THE PC SCREEN INTERMITTENTLY APPEARS AND DISAPPEARS

Make sure the connection between the TV and the computer is connected securely.

THE MESSAGE "NO SIGNAL" APPEARS ON THE SCREEN

- This may happen if the settings of your video card on the computer exceed the maximum supported resolution or frequency of the TV. Try to adjust the settings of your video card according to the TV's specifications.
- 2. See if Power Saving mode of the PC functions properly. (This is deactivated when any key is pressed or the mouse is moved)

THE SCREEN LOOKS LIKE THERE IS WATER FLOWING ON IT

Make sure all signal cables linked to the TV is securely connected.

THE SCREEN IS UNCLEAR AND BLURRY

Change the frequency and phase adjustment on the TV. Change the Resolution and frequency on the PC to the standard limit. THE SCREEN IS UNSTABLE AND FLICKERING

Please set the resolution and frequency of the PC's Graphics Card within the TV's supported range.

SOME MODES IN THE STANDARD MODE ARE NOT WORKING

- 1. Check the compatibility of the video card with the TV.
- 2. Upgrade the software of the graphics card, and try again.
