

The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.
Do not use rechargeable batteries.
Keep product away from extreme heat.

BATTERY INSTRUCTIONS:

1. REMOVE BATTERY COMPARTMENT COVERS ON VEHICLE AND TRANSMITTER AS SHOWN
2. INSTALL ONE "AA" AND TWO "AAA" ALKALINE BATTERIES IN THE BATTERY COMPARTMENTS WITH POSITIVE (+) AND NEGATIVE (-) ENDS MATCHING THE COMPARTMENT MARKINGS
3. REPLACE THE BATTERY COVERS

OPERATION:

1. START: MOVE SWITCH UNDERNEATH THE VEHICLE TO "ON" POSITION
2. FORWARD: PRESS  BUTTON TO GO FORWARD
3. REVERSE & TURNING: PRESS  BUTTON TO GO BACKWARD CURVE
