### HOW TO OPERATE YOUR TRANSCIEVER:

1. Open battery cover and strap in a 9-volt battery.
2. Turn the "ON-OFF" switch to "ON" position. Your transceiver is now ready to operate.
3. Press the "PUSH-TO-TALK" switch for transmitting.
4. Release the "PUSH-TO-TALK" switch for receiving.
5. When transmitting, speak clearly in a normal voice, holding the set about 3" from your mouth.
6. Best transmission and reception are obtained when the antenna is held in a vertical position.

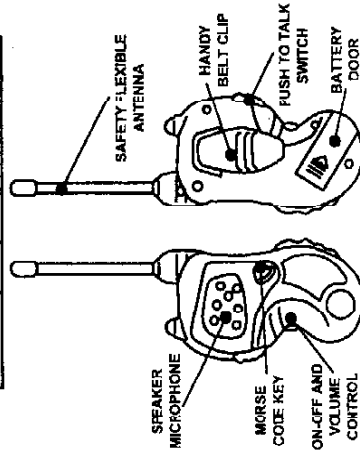
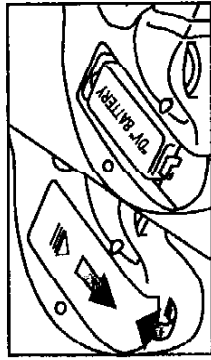
### HOW TO USE MORSE CODE FUNCTION:

1. For transmitting a signal, turn the "ON-OFF" switch to "ON" position.
2. While pushing the "PUSH-TO-TALK" button, press in the morse code button momentarily and release for desired signals.
3. For receiving a signal, adjust volume control for normal listening level.
4. When back to voice communications again, use normal "PUSH TO-TALK" operation.
