Dear Mr. Noble:

We are submitting the attached Permissive Change Application for the Axonn SPT1. The reason for the Permissive Change is that we found some errors in the originally submitted test report.

1) More appropriate Output Power data was available but mistakenly left out on the report submitted to ATCB. We had tested a number of samples, and had output power data for each of these. Axonn requested that we use the data for the sample with the highest output power so that this data would agree with what is reflected in their literature. The entire report, as submitted was for the sample with the highest output power; however the incorrect data for the output power was put in the final report submitted to ATCB. There was no error in the measurements, and the rest of the report data was correct and is not affected by this change. This error was discovered by Axonn after they had a chance to review their test report, but by this time, the grant had already been approved by the FCC.

2) Calibration dates on the equipment were not correct.

3) Also, Axonn has noticed that even though we have submitted updated address and contact information for their company, outdated information still shows on their grant. The correct contact information for Axonn should be:
