Here are my responses to the FCC inquiry below. Please go ahead, get the PBA process completed as instructed by Vina and issie the Grant for the jobs REC71UW and RED71UW models today Monday Nov 7.

Here are the responses:

>> TCB may proceed with Form 731 and exhibit upload and return with TC confirmation numbers. However, please advise the applicant that both 20 mm and 15 mm (with and without holster) SAR measurement distances need better justification/explanation, including drawing and/or photos if necessary.

[MA] Attached is revised SAR Appendix E with pictures/justification/explanation regarding 20 mm holster distance and 15 mm separation distance used for body SAR compliance measurements.

>> In addition, the EUT is capable of transmitting in the 5150-5250 MHz band which allows only indoor application. How does the applicant plan to effectively comply to this indoor rule?

[MA] The EUT as a client-only device will always follow the Access Point (AP) for compliance to this indoor rule. There are no user configurable settings to override this treatment.

>> Furthermore, in addition to DFS client tests, the use of 5600-5650 MHz is prohibited; users should not have option to avoid the block-out. It is not clear whether the current channel pool has notched out this band.

[MA] These channels are not used and are not included in any allowed channel pool. There are no user settings to allow the use of prohibited frequency range of 5600-5650.
