Overall Assessment Letter for Permissive Change to Nokia WTA GSM 850 Transceiver Radio Module

The WTPA GSM 850 Transceiver is was approved as a Radio Module within a MetroSite Edge Base station. The approval permitted co-location with up to 3 other Nokia radio modules (comprising any mix of the WTPA GSM 1900 or WTPA GSM 850 transceiver modules) This change is to permit the co-location of up to 6 MetroSite Edge base stations within the HcHc housing thus increase the co-transmission limit from 3 to 23.

I have reviewed the application and found it to be compliant. The following has been noted during the evaluation.

1: Test Configuration

To avoid over-testing it was agreed that the test configuration would comprise of 12 of each type of permitted module. Each set of cards would be configured to ensure that the highest and lowest permitted channels were included within the test configuration , with a spread of other channels within the configuration.
