- 1) In order to comply with the RF Safety requirements. The manual for the N6RFHSS-900 contains the statement "Warning: prolonged human exposure to antenna at distances closer than 20 cm(8in), could exceed FCC MPE(maximum permissible exposure) limits."
- 2) The antenna connector is a non-standard reverse gender SMA connector
- 3) In order to ensure Class A use, we will address the marketing following restrictions.
 - a) I verify that the device will not be sold to the General Public and will not be sold to distributors that sell to the General Public.
 - b) I verify that OEM customers will be notified that end user products based on these modules must be commercial in nature.
 - c) I verify that the following will be placed in the manual. "This module has been tested to class A FCC limits. It's use is limited to commercial applications without further FCC compliance testing. This module cannot be resold to the general public."
- 4) Modules will be provided with a second label that must be affixed to the outside of the enclosure of the end product for identification purposes. An example of the label will be sent with this document.
- 5) The text "Place the label in a conspicuous area on the enclosure of the end product." Will be included in the OEM manual.
