Subject: Label location justification letter as per 47CFR Part 2.925(d) requirements

Product: A 700/800 MHz PTT handheld portable 3W transceiver with built in GPS and Bluetooth
Model: U3-700-800

To whom it may concern,

Our U3 2-way public safety radio follows an industry standard practice of placing the FCC label on the back of the radio and inside the battery compartment for the following reasons:

1. There is no space to place the label on the front, sides, top, and bottom of the unit due to the keypad, LCD display, the buttons, knobs, antenna, accessory port, PTT button, customer logo, and the many contoured surfaces.
2. The label will be readily viewable (as per 2.925(d)) on the back of the U3 radio whenever the batteries are removed for charging or replacement. The battery is designed for easy removal.
3. At the time of purchase, as per 2.925(d), the label will be readily visible because the device will be packaged and sold without the battery installed.
