**Connecting To Other Devices**

When connecting to any other device, read its user's guide for detailed safety instructions. Do not connect incompatible products. Remember to make backup copies of all important data.

**Making Calls**

Ensure the phone is switched on and in service. Enter the phone number, including the area code, then press TALK. To end a call press END. To answer a call press TALK.

**Emergency Calls**

Ensure the phone is switched on and in service. If the word "Clear" appears on the display above the <right selection> key, press and hold Clear to clear the display. Enter the emergency number, then press TALK. Give your location. Do not end the call until told to do so.

**Infrared Precautions**

Do not point the IR beam at anyone's eyes or allow it to interfere with other IR devices.

## About the labels on your phone

Your phone has labels on it. These are important for service and related purposes, so be careful no to lose the label or the information it contains.

## FCC/Industry Canada Notice

Your phone may cause TV or radio interference (for example, when using a telephone in close proximity to receiving equipment).
